
VISITORS CENTER FLOOR PLAN



The accompanying Visitors Center features spaces divided into three sections, each representing a different zone of the sun:

The Core – A circular visitor desk sits at the center, creating a centralized floor plan where guests naturally circumambulate. On the south end of the building, this space receives the most light.

The Radiative Zone – Grade level paths aid in radiating visitors throughout the building, and a ramp allows access to the depressed event space. Positioned on the west side, this space

receives ample evening light.
The Convection Zone – A single hallway guides guests up and out (or back down and in), symbolizing convection. Lined with rooms on the east side, this section heavily benefits from the morning light.
